Human-wildlife conflict (HWC) is fast becoming a critical threat to the survival of many globally endangered species, in particular to large and rare mammals such as the Sumatran tiger (*Panthera tigris sumatrae*) and the Asian lion (*Panthera leo persica*), but also to less endangered species such as the snow leopard (*Uncia uncia*) and the Red colobus monkey (*Procolopus kirkii*)
